

## **Robin Industries Inc. Employees' Educational Resource Fund**

For employees and family members of **Robin Industries, Inc.:** Elasto-Tec Division, Robin Technical Services, Holmco Division, Fredericksburg Facility, Cleveland Division, Sharon Center Mold & Die and Berlin Division

### **THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Educational Resource Fund is a scholarship fund created for the employees and family members of Robin industries, Inc. The Fund helps eligible persons study at a university, college or recognized educational or job training program. Unlike many scholarship funds, it may also support education or job training that develops a unique skill or talent.

The Educational Resource Fund awards scholarships three times a year. Scholarships are for one year, but can be renewed annually. In the case of educational or job training programs, scholarships are for the length of the course.

The Fund was established at The Cleveland Foundation by an anonymous donor. An independent Selection Committee, chosen by the Foundation, makes decisions on scholarships. Foundation staff administers the fund and provides advice to interested individuals.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible, you must meet these requirements:

- 1) Be an employee of Robin Industries, Inc .and employed full or part time, continuously, for the last two years, or
- 2) Be a family member, including a spouse, domestic partner, dependent (child, stepchild or grandchild) or parent of an eligible employee of Robin Industries, Inc and
- 3) Already be admitted to the class or program for which you are seeking support

### **This application accepted anytime through October 15, 2014**

(Important: Please submit your application prior to the beginning date of your class(es). There will be no back-funding for classes begun before Selection Committee consideration.)

The Selection Committee bases its scholarship decisions on the completed application and continuation of three criteria: career or life goals and objectives, educational history and personal character. Financial need is considered when demand is greater than available resources. Award amounts are based upon the earnings of the fund. The current range is from 100% of the cost of tuition and fees to a maximum of \$500 for part-time honorary awards to \$3,000 for full-time status.
