HAF Connects: the sustainable art of plastics began in 2019 under the auspices of the Urban Bright Art Residency at Art House, Inc. Ron Shelton, artist, and publisher of the online arts magazine, High Art Fridays (HAF), engaged twenty-three energetic 3rd graders about how plastics are invading our culture, our environment, and our lives. With funding from The Cleveland Foundation and The Ohio Arts Council, the project has evolved into a global campaign utilizing creative contributions from Ghana, S. Korea, El Salvador, United Kingdom, Los Angeles, California, and ten artists from Northeast Ohio, including the Visit Arts Collective. 24-inch tall, hand-built wire cone frame structures embellished with plastics from each of the artists' community is the theme for this exhibition.
